FIRST LESSON A Reading from the Book of Proverbs

Does not wisdom call, and does not understanding raise her voice? On heights, beside the way, at the crossroads she takes her stand; beside the gates in front of the town, at the entrance of the portals she cries out: "To you, O people, I call, and my cry is to all that live.
